

Performance expectations for the **Eyes** practical

Explain the procedure and report the results to the patient for each exam. You will have 8 minutes to perform the following from memory:

1. Demonstrate appropriate professionalism and demeanor when speaking with the patient.
2. Properly introduce yourself to the patient and explain the procedures you will perform.
3. Properly perform the external eye exam (naming at least 3 observations) and distance visual acuity testing (Snellen or Sloan chart)
4. Properly perform the assessment of the peripheral fields.
5. Properly perform the assessment of the cardinal planes of gaze.
6. Properly perform the assessment of the pupillary reflexes (accommodation, corneal light reflex/reflection, direct and indirect reflexes).
7. Properly perform the internal ophthalmoscopic eye exam bilaterally, naming all findings you observe.
8. Properly perform an ophthalmoscopic examination on the models (at the discretion of the instructor).

Bring your oto/ophthalmoscope and a 3 X 5 card.
