

## Performance expectations for the **Ears, Nose, and Throat** practical

**Explain the procedure and report the results to the patient for each exam. You will have 8 minutes to perform the following from memory:**

1. Demonstrate appropriate professionalism and demeanor when speaking with the patient.
2. Properly introduce yourself to the patient and explain the procedures you will perform.
3. Properly perform the external ear assessment (naming at least 3 observations).
4. Properly perform the internal otoscopic ear exam bilaterally, naming all findings you observe.
5. Properly perform the external assessment of the nose (naming at least 3 observations) and nasal patency.
6. Properly perform the internal nasal passages exam bilaterally, naming all findings you observe.
7. Assess the sinuses with palpation and percussion. For this practical, you will not perform sinus transillumination.
8. Properly perform the assessment of the external mouth (naming at least 3 observations).
9. Properly perform the internal mouth and throat, naming all findings you observe.
10. Properly perform an otoscopic and/or ophthalmoscopic examination on the models (at the discretion of the instructor).

Bring your oto/ophthalmoscope and speculum covers. Tongue depressors/blades will be provided.
